

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Requesting Emergency Assistance - San Lucy Sewer Pond Damage)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 93-051**

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3 **WHEREAS,** the San Lucy District has hydration ponds designed and  
4 constructed by Indian Health Services located on reservation  
5 land within the Painted Rock Reservoir area; and  
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7 **WHEREAS,** the hydration ponds were built to prevent flood waters below  
8 the 658 ft. elevation level to damage said ponds and interrupt  
9 sewerage service to the District; and  
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11 **WHEREAS,** estimates provided the Emergency Operations Control (EOC),  
12 Army Corps of Engineers indicate that the water level within  
13 the reservoir will exceed the 658 level; and  
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15 **WHEREAS,** flood water above the 658 foot level will result in the hydration  
16 ponds becoming inoperable for an extended period of time and  
17 discontinue sewer service for the District; and  
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19 **WHEREAS,** Indian Health Service engineers have inspected and reviewed  
20 the conditions pertaining to the Hydration Ponds and in  
21 conjunction with District Officials and staff have established a  
22 contingency plan to continue sewer service when flood waters  
23 exceed the 658 ft. level; and  
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25 **WHEREAS,** Indian Health Services had identified emergency funding to  
26 implement said contingency plan; and

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3 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council approved District Council**  
4 **Resolution No. 1-33-93 requesting the Tohono O'Odham**  
5 **Legislative Council to support the expenditure of Indian Health**  
6 **Service funds and request continuing technical assistance**  
7 **services from Indian Health Service engineering staff for the**  
8 **implementation of the proposed contingency plan; and**

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11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and**  
12 **considered San Lucy District's request.**

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14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham**  
15 **Legislative Council that the request for the expenditure of**  
16 **Indian Health Service funds and continuing technical support**  
17 **to implement the proposed I.H.S. Emergency Contingency Plan**  
18 **for San Lucy District Hydration Ponds is hereby approved.**

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22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
23 **Council on the 3RD. day of FEBRUARY, 1993 at a meeting at which a**  
24 **quorum was present with a vote of 1,660.5 FOR; 63.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT**  
25 **VOTING; and 01 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
26 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
27 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved**  
28 **by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on**  
**March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.**  
**984).**
