

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting \$100,000 in Federal Funding for Chui Chu
Water Inventory, and Authorizing Related
Modification to P. L. 93-638 Contract and
Amendment to Subcontract)**

RESOLUTION NO. 93-072

WHEREAS, by Resolution 91-364, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council authorized the execution of a P. L. 93-638 Contract (the "Contract") in the amount of \$250,000 to fund the Chuichu Water Inventory Study in the Sif Oidak District and further authorized the execution of a subcontract (the "Subcontract") with National Resources Consulting Engineers ("NRCE") to conduct the Water Inventory; and

WHEREAS, by Modification No. 2, an additional award of \$150,000 was added to the Contract and the Contract was extended to March 31, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Subcontract was amended to similarly increase the amount and extend its term; and

WHEREAS, as reported to the Legislative Council and the Sif Oidak District, NRCE has determined that completion of the water rights quantification and damage assessment will require an expansion of the Study area to encompass connected water basins in the Hickiwan, Gu Achi, Sells and Schuk Toak Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Nation has received an award of \$100,000 in federal funds

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under P. L. 93-638 which is available to conduct the expanded
Study; and

**WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance and Water Resources Committee
recommend expanding the Water Inventory to the other
affected Districts.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The award of \$100,000 in supplemental funding for the
P. L. 93-638 Contract on the Chuichu Water Inventory
Study is hereby accepted.**
- 2. The Chairman of the Nation and the Water Resources
Committee, in consultation with the Attorney General and
Office of Grants and Contracts, are authorized to (a)
negotiate and execute Modification No. 3 to the Contract
and Amendment No. 3 to the NRCE Subcontract which (1)
incorporate the supplemental funding and (2) expand the
scope of the Water Inventory to include a water
quantification and damage assessment for connected basins
in the Hickiwan, Gu Achi, Sells and Schuk Toak Districts
and (b) execute such further modifications to the Contract**

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and Subcontract as may be appropriate, provided that any such
revision shall not change the amount of funding or scope of
work without prior approval of the Legislative Council.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 8TH. day of MARCH, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,607.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 116.5 NOT
VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1 (f) of Article VI and Section 2 of Article XVII of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


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


