- WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District with the support of the Gu Vo District hereby requests fencing material to replace the International Boundary fence in order to alleviate some of the problems along the International United States/Mexican Boundary.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby supports the Border Fending request in the amount of \$230,406.00 as outlined in the attached budget proposal.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate members and committees of Congress.
