

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1993 Water Projects Office Budget Amendment  
for 04/01/93 to 09/30/93)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 93-105**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Water Projects Office to provide administrative services under a P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Reclamation for the development of farm projects in the San Xavier and Schuk Toak Districts; and**

**WHEREAS, as of October 1, 1991 the Bureau of Reclamation did not extend the contracts for design of the farm projects; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by means of Resolutions 92-269, 92-270 and 92-271 approved budgets and scopes of work for FY 1993 to be submitted to the Bureau of Reclamation for either extensions of the above mentioned contracts or for negotiation of a new P. L. 93-638 Cooperative Agreement; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council provided interim funding for FY 1992 and the first half of FY 1993 from General Revenues and the SAWRSA Trust Fund to maintain operation of the Water Projects Office; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council reviewed and approved and an Implementation Plan for the Water Projects Office; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office has submitted an application for a**  
4 **Cooperative Agreement under P. L. 93-638 to the Bureau of**  
5 **Reclamation to complete designs for the San Xavier Cooperative**  
6 **Farm Rehabilitation and the Schuk Toak Farm; and**

9 **WHEREAS, under P. L. 93-638, the Bureau of Reclamation is required to**  
10 **respond to the Water Projects Office's proposal within a**  
11 **specific timeframe; and**

12  
13 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office finds that it must submit a budget to**  
14 **cover staff salaries, support costs and subcontracts to be**  
15 **approved in the interim while the proposal is negotiated with**  
16 **the Bureau of Reclamation; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office is requesting from the Tohono**  
19 **O'Odham Nation a modification to the first and second**  
20 **quarters' budget in the amount of \$269,820.00 to enable the**  
21 **operation of the Water Projects Office to continue until a**  
22 **Cooperative Agreement is satisfactorily negotiated between the**  
23 **Tohono O'Odham Nation and the Bureau of Reclamation.**  
24 **Reimbursement for those costs attributable to the contracts will**  
25 **be sought through the Bureau of Reclamation once the**  
26 **Cooperative Agreement is executed.**



5 **Legislative Council** that it does hereby approve the funding  
6 **request and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the**  
7 **attached budget.**

9 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that funds in the amount of \$269,820.00 are  
10 **hereby appropriated from the SAWRSA Trust Fund to cover**  
11 **the period from 04/01/93 through 09/30/93.**

13 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that reimbursement for such funds advanced  
14 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation that are determined to be**  
15 **allocable to the contracts will be sought from the Bureau of**  
16 **Reclamation.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
20 **Council on the 14TH. day of APRIL, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum**  
21 **was present with a vote of 1,378.0 FOR; 346.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT**  
22 **VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
23 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**  
24 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**  
25 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
26 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,**  
27 **1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
