RESOLUTION NO. 93-116

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in 1982 replacing the Comprehensive Employment Training Act (CETA); and

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) funds are made available to State and Tribal Governments from the United States Department of Labor to establish employment and training programs for improving the employment prospects of eligible persons; and

WHEREAS, Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated as service delivery areas and are eligible to receive Federal JTPA funds; and

WHEREAS, the Nation is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a network of employment training programs throughout the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Title IV-A program since 1974; and

WHEREAS, the JTPA Program has submitted for review and approval the Title IV-A Grant Proposal for Fiscal Year 1994, which includes:

- Comprehensive Annual Plan;**
- FY 1994 Administrative Cost Pool Budget in the amount of \$85,774.00 and;**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council that it hereby approves the Comprehensive
Annual Plan and the Title IV-A Budget in the amount of
\$428,872.00 for the delivery of JTPA services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided
however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding
levels of this grant shall be submitted for further prior approval
by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 15TH. day of APRIL, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,566.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING;
and 158.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved
by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
