

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Judges Pro Tempore of the Tohono O'Odham Courts)**

RESOLUTION NO. 93-139

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is empowered by**
4 **Article VIII, Section 4 of the Constitution of the Tohono**
5 **O'Odham Nation to appoint judges of the Tohono O'Odham**
6 **Courts; and**

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8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did by Ordinance No.**
9 **01-89, Chapter II, authorize the appointment of judges pro**
10 **tempore to the Tohono O'Odham Courts upon the**
11 **recommendation of the Chief Judge; and**

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13 **WHEREAS, the Chief Judge has submitted the names of attorneys qualified**
14 **pursuant to 2-103 of Ordinance No. 01-89 and recommended**
15 **their appointment as judges pro tempore of the Tohono**
16 **O'Odham Courts; and**

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19 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 91-145 appointed judges pro tempore for terms**
20 **of two years; and**

21 **WHEREAS, four judges pro tempore terms will expire effective May 1,**
22 **1993; and**

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24 **WHEREAS, the Chief Judge has submitted the names of four attorneys**
25 **qualified to fill the current expired terms of judge pro tempore;**
26 **and**

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28 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee has met with the Chief Judge and**

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discussed the qualifications of the individuals who are being recommended for appointment as judges pro tempore; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee has determined that the persons recommended are of good moral character, residents of the State of Arizona for not less than five years, and are admitted to the practice of law for not less than three years; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee does concur with the recommendations of the Chief Judge and recommends to the full Legislative Council four appointments of judges pro tempore for the Judicial Branch of this Nation..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does accept the recommendation of the Chief Judge, and in accordance with Judicial Branch Rules and Procedures formally adopted by this Legislative Council by Ordinance 01-89, hereby appoints the following named persons as judges pro tempore of the Tohono O'Odham Judicial Branch for terms set forth next to their respective names to wit:

Robert A. Williams, Jr. - 2 years

Violet Po Lui-Frank - 2 years

Steve M. Titla - 2 years

Gary L. Thomas - 2 years

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointments of the foregoing named persons shall become effective on the 1st day of May, 1993.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 4TH. day of MAY, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,269.5 FOR; 296.5 AGAINST; 158.0 NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


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
