3 **WHEREAS, on May 18, 1993, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
4 **convened in a Special Session to address the drafted Water**
5 **Code of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

6 **WHEREAS, it was recommended that the Council activate ARTICLE VI-**
7 **DEBATE, Section 3 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION, Section 3.A.**
8 **"OPENING FLOOR FOR PUBLIC," of the Policies and**
9 **Procedures of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
10 **(Legislative Rules) which states:**

13 **"The Legislative Council prior to the debate, upon a motion and**
14 **a second, may vote to open the discussion for public**
15 **participation by tribal members/staff in attendance. If this**
16 **action is not taken, tribal members/staff must obtain**
17 **recognition through their District Legislative Representative or**
18 **other members of the Legislature."**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
20 **Council that it hereby to provides for public participation in this**
21 **meeting's discussion in accordance to ARTICLE VI-DEBATE,**
22 **Section 3 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION, Section 3.A. "OPENING**
23 **FLOOR FOR PUBLIC," of the Policies and Procedures of the**
24 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**




