3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did on Saturday, May 22, 1993**
4 **conduct a general election for the offices of Representatives and**
5 **Alternates to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Election Board did issue and post its Certificates of Election**
8 **Results in accordance with Section 6(E) of Article VII of the**
9 **Uniform Election Ordinance, certifying to the election of the**
10 **candidates who received the highest number of votes for elective**
11 **office; and**

13 **WHEREAS, under Section 6(N) of Article VII of the Uniform Election**
14 **Ordinance, it is incumbent upon this Council to issue**
15 **Certificates of Election to the candidates who received the**
16 **highest number of votes for each Council seat within twenty**
17 **days after the Election Board has posted its Certificates of**
18 **Election Results, provided however, that no election contest**
19 **statement has been filed against the candidates within the time**
20 **allowed and provided for, and provided further that they hold**
21 **no other elective office of the Nation.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 7TH. day of JUNE, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,349.0 FOR; 213.0 AGAINST; 162.0 NOT VOTING; and 01 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (g) of Article VI and Section 7 of Article X of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
