13 WHEREAS, under Section 6(N) of Article VII of the Uniform Election 14 Ordinance, it is incumbent upon this Council to issue 15 Certificates of Election to the candidates who received the 16 17 highest number of votes for each Council seat within twenty 18 days after the Election Board has posted its Certificates of 19 Election Results, provided however, that no election contest 20 21 statement has been filed against the candidates within the time 22 allowed and provided for, and provided further that they hold 23 no other elective office of the Nation. 24 25
