

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1994 Psychological Services - Children's Initiative
Component Recontract Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 93-188

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
Psychological Services - Children's Initiative Component under
an FY 1993 P. L. 93-638 contract with the Public Health,
Indian Health Services; and**

**WHEREAS, 42 CFR 36.205 of the Code of Federal Regulations requires that
all proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to
the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council for approval at least
120 days prior to the current contract termination; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to recontract for
provision of services during FY 1994; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
approved the FY 1994 Psychological Services - Children's
Initiative Component recontract proposal and budgets.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council does authorize and request the Public
Health, Indian Health Service to recontract with the Tohono
O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and
procedures for the provision of services titled: Psychological
Services.**

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this recontract shall
commence on October 01, 1993 through September 30, 1994.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the
program in the interim while negotiations are still being
conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by the
Indian Health Service, unless the agency authorizes and
approves pre-award costs consistent with the Indian
Self-Determination Act, as amended, and relevant contract
regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the
Chairman, and any designated official are hereby authorized to
negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any
amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 8TH. day of JUNE, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was
present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and
05 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of

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Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


