

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Providing Authority to San Lucy District to Contract 93-638 Funds  
for Substance Abuse Services)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 93-223**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Constitution (1986) Article IX,  
Section 5, delegates to Districts within the Nation the authority  
and responsibilities to govern themselves in all matters of local  
concern; and**

**WHEREAS, San Lucy District is located in the Phoenix Service Unit and  
receives medical services, including field health, nutritional,  
social work, educational, and technical assistance from said  
Service Area; and**

**WHEREAS, San Lucy District receives Alcohol Abuse and Prevention and  
Treatment Services from Indian Rehabilitation Services Inc.,  
under a Purchase Order Agreement with the Phoenix Area  
Office; and**

**WHEREAS, the maximum allowable amount under a Purchase Order is  
\$25,000.00 per year and the current demand for substance  
related services is greater than the ability to provide services  
within the financial limits set forth in a Purchase Order  
Agreement; and**

**WHEREAS, the Phoenix Service Area will enter into a 93-638 Contract with  
San Lucy District for the delivery of Substance Abuse Services,**

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thus increasing the amount of funding available to the District,  
provided the Tohono O'odham Nation grants authority to the  
District to enter into 93-638 Contracts with the Phoenix Service  
Area; and

**WHEREAS, the San Lucy District, in accordance with Area Office  
instructions, prepared a Scope of Work, Budget and Job  
Descriptions for the proposed Contract; and**

**WHEREAS, on June 5, 1992, the District Council reviewed said documents  
and adopted Resolution No. 06-19-92, requesting that the  
Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopt a Resolution  
providing authority to the District to enter into a 93-638  
Contract with the Phoenix Service Area; and**

**WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Legislative Committee reviewed  
said request on July 30, 1992, recommended approval and  
suggested the District forward said request and documents to  
the Executive Office for review; and**

**WHEREAS, the San Lucy District submitted said documents and request to  
the Executive Office on August 20, 1992; and**

**WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Legislative Committee reviewed the  
District's documents on February 22, 1993 and requested  
commentary from the Executive Office; and**

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3 **WHEREAS, on March 1, 1993, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,**

5 **upon considering San Lucy District Council Resolution No.**  
6 **06-19-92, moved that formal action on the District's request be**  
7 **delayed, pending commentary from the Executive Office; and**

8 **WHEREAS, on April 6, 1993, District Representatives and the Executive**  
9 **Staff Attorney reviewed said documents and the District's**  
10 **request.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham**  
13 **Legislative Council, upon further consideration of the District's**  
14 **request and recommendations by the Executive Office, that the**  
15 **San Lucy District is hereby granted the authority to enter into**  
16 **the Proposed 93-638 Contract with the Phoenix Area Office,**  
17 **Indian Health Services.**  
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20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Lucy District Chairperson is**  
21 **hereby granted the authority to negotiate said contracts on**  
22 **behalf of the District and, further, the San Lucy District shall**  
23 **assume all audit, financial, and administrative responsibilities**  
24 **associated within said Contract, therein, holding the Nation**  
25 **harmless, should the District fail to uphold financial, reporting**  
26 **or performance requirements within said Contract.**  
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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 11TH day of JUNE, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,058.0 FOR; 178.0 AGAINST; 403.0 NOT VOTING; and 124.0 (08) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) & (l) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






