**WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients has been beneficial and services continue to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of individuals at risk; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of additional funding for our Women, Infant and Children Program, due to an increase in our client caseload; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding level of the Memorandum of Agreement with the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham Community Health Services; Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the amendment and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, and any designated official are hereby authorized to**




8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative


