

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Certification of Selection Criteria utilized by the Districts for
the HUD Indian Home Grant Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 93-233

**WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban
Development Indian Home Grant program has made \$10 million
dollars available to all reservations nationwide for the purposes
of providing new homes and renovations to existing homes for
Native Americans in need of housing and housing repairs; and**

**WHEREAS, HUD guidelines require a selection criteria for identifying those
families most in need of housing who will receive HUD Indian
Home Grant monies; and**

**WHEREAS, the 1991 Tohono O'Odham Nation's Housing Authority
inventory and assessment of housing within the boundaries of
the Nation stands as a complete and accurate description of the
housing needs of the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the need for housing among the Tohono O'Odham residing on
the lands of the Tohono O'Odham Nation is some twelve times
greater than the total \$10 million available through the HUD
Indian Home Grant program, thus forcing each district applying
for the funds to artificially cap its housing needs to the selection
of families for 10 new homes and 11 homes for rehabilitation;

4 **WHEREAS, each District's selection criteria defined as families or**
5 **households with elderly or handicapped members; families who**
6 **were waiting the longest for housing benefits; families who lived**
7 **in a structurally unstable home, or a home in need or urgent**
8 **repairs (i.e. roof replacement), or a home with no amenities (i.e.**
9 **indoor plumbing, sewage lines or electricity); families living in**
10 **an older building with cultural value; families with very low**
11 **income which does not exceed 50 percent of the median income**
12 **for the area (adjusted for family size), and that those families**
13 **selected fell well within the HUD guidelines for very low income**
14 **for the Tucson, Arizona area; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Office for Planning and**
19 **Research undertook a cost estimate for each of the proposed**
20 **new buildings and renovations and that the estimate conformed**
21 **to the standards of the National Association of Real Estate**
22 **Appraisers.**

28 **to HUD for funding**




