

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1994 Head Start Program Grant Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 93-251

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has recognized the importance of**
4 **Head Start Education and stimulation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated a Head Start**
6 **Program to provide and serve educational and pre-school**
7 **learning experiences for children between the ages of 3 - 5 years**
8 **of age; and**

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10 **WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration**
11 **for Children, Youth and Families, has provided funding for the**
12 **operation of the Head Start Program; and**

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14 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Children, Youth and Families will**
15 **provide funds for the continued operation of the Head Start**
16 **Program to legal and qualifying applicants; and**

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18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and**
19 **approved the Head Start Program Grant Proposal.**

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21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham**
22 **Legislative Council that it does authorize and request the**
23 **Department of Health and Human Services to contract with the**
24 **Tohono O'Odham Nation for the provision of services titled:**
25 **Head Start Program.**
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3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
4 Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or
5 operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still
6 being conducted and no executed contract has been approved by
7 the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration
8 for Child, Youth and Families.

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11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
12 Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit:
13 the Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized
14 to negotiate and execute the contract provided, however, that
15 any amendments affecting the funding or fund levels of this
16 contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
17 Council.

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21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
22 Council on the 15TH day of JULY, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum
23 was present with a vote of 1,665.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING;
24 and 98.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
25 Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
26 adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved
27 by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
28 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
