**RESOLUTION NO. 93-263**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Career  
Center Program under FY 1993 P. L. 93-638 contract with the  
Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs notified the Nation that Tribal  
Essential Services funds were available for distribution as  
identified by the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did submit a letter to the Bureau  
of Indian Affairs requesting that Fiscal Year 1993 Tribal  
Essential Services fund in the amount of \$233,000.00 be  
allocated to the Career Center Program; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
contract shall be submitted for review and approval by the  
Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval  
reflecting an increase of funds in the amount of \$233,000.00 for  
the Career Center Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment to the  
Career Center Program Contract No. 1450CTH54T61033, and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council

that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to  
negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any  
amendment affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this  
Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council on the 19TH day of JULY, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum  
was present with a vote of 1,590.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 173.0 NOT  
VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,  
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved  
by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).




