**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has consistently supported the
nurturance of its young members by providing for their welfare
through various programs and services designed to meet their
special needs; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of funding for the Rural Project
Program for disabled 3 to 5 years old through the Bureau of
Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 102-119, The Individuals
with Disabilities Education Act as amended; and**

**WHEREAS, several meetings have taken place to discuss the transition of
operation from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to the Tohono
O'Odham Nation and implementation of Public Law 102-119;
and**

**WHEREAS, the Rural Project Program has been operated throughout the
Tohono O'Odham Nation and has served many Tohono
O'Odham children by the Bureau of Indian Affairs Department
of Education; and**

**WHEREAS, funds are to be used to assist the State Lead Agency in child
find, screening, and other procedures for the early identification
of children aged 3 - 5 inclusive, and for parent training.**

18 **approves pre-award costs consistent with the Indian Self-**
19 **Determination Act, as amended, and relevant contract**






