

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Recommending Steps and Procedures to be implemented
by the Chairman of the Nation on Proposed
Administrative Plan)**

RESOLUTION NO. 93-271

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did discuss on July 16, 1993 the merger of the Health & Social Services programs by the Chairman of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, defeated Resolution No. 93-256 attempted to stop payment of any salaries for any new positions/appointments until review of the proposed merger of the Tohono O'odham Health Department and the Tohono O'odham Social Services, and review of the Administrative Plan takes place by the Legislative Council, and until the Nation receives authorization from the funding agencies; and

WHEREAS, upon further discussion by the Budget & Finance Committee and the Health & Human Services Committee of the previous action taken, it was the recommendation of these committees that this item be brought back to the Council for further discussion and action; and

WHEREAS, concerns have been voiced to Legislative Representatives from some of the Nation's districts and programs regarding the Administrative Plan and the program merger; and

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**WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the committees that the following
steps take place:**

- 1. The internal process for the creation of new positions and the hiring process takes place.**
- 2. The plan of the proposed merger of the two programs is reviewed and adopted.**
- 3. The Administrative Plan is reviewed by the Nation as a whole, and adopted by the Legislative Council.**
- 4. Completed negotiations have taken place between the Nation and funding agencies (Indian Health Services & Bureau of Indian Affairs).**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there will be no payments
made for any newly appointed or newly created positions, under
the proposed Administrative Plan, until the above-identified
steps are carried out, namely:**

- 1. The internal process for the creation of new positions and the hiring process takes place.**
- 2. The plan of the proposed merger of the two programs is reviewed and adopted.**
- 3. The Administrative Plan is reviewed by the Nation as a whole, and adopted by the Legislative Council.**
- 4. Completed negotiations have taken place between the Nation and funding agencies (Indian Health Services & Bureau of Indian Affairs).**

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
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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any appointments made be brought

allocation or expenditures of any funds are authorized.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 20TH day of JULY, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,380.0 FOR; 315.0 AGAINST; 68.0 NOT
VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1(b) & (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
