**RESOLUTION NO. 93-292**

**WHEREAS, the concept of transferring the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Agency Facility Management to the Office of Indian Education Programs - Papago Agency was addressed to the Tohono O'Odham Education Committee/Board of Directions, Agency School Board and Human Resources Development Committee in 1991; and**

**WHEREAS, the Education Committee/Board of Directors and the Agency School Boards did enact resolutions in support of the transfer of Facility Management to the Office of Indian Education; and**

**WHEREAS, on July 29, 1993 this issue was readdressed to the Education Committee/Board of Directors and the Human Resources Development Committee with recommendations presented by the Office of Indian Education, BIA-Papago Agency; and**

**WHEREAS, upon further discussions by the Education Committee/Board of Directors and Human Resources Development Committee on the recommendations provided, find that the Office of Indian Education Papago Agency is not prepared to undertake the duties and responsibilities of the Facility Management; and**

**WHEREAS, the Education Committee/Board of Directors and Human Resources Development Committee did discuss the**

Facility Management to the Office of Indian Education - Papago  
Agency at this time.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
supports the recommendations from the Education  
Committee/Board of Directors, Education Office - Papago  
Agency, Human Resources Development Committee and the  
Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council to consult with the school  
Boards and Districts for further discussions.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Human Resources Development  
Committee and Education Committee/Board of Directors follow  
through on this issue and that this item be brought back to the  
Council at a later date for action.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council on the 5TH day of AUGUST, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum  
was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT  
VOTING; and 04 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by




