2. The Chairman of the Legislative Council and the Chairman of the Nation are authorized and directed to transmit such objections in writing to appropriate Congressional Committees, federal officials and other persons.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the <u>16TH</u>, day of <u>SEPTEMBER</u>, <u>1993</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,763.0 FOR</u>; <u>-0- AGAINST</u>; <u>-0- NOT VOTING</u>; and <u>01 ABSENT</u>, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section <u>1(j)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
