3 **WHEREAS,** at the "Conference on Exploring Solutions to Native American  
4 **Transportation and Economic Development Programs"** held in  
5 **May 1993,** tribal leaders expressed the need to create an  
6 **organization that would permit them to communicate with all**  
7 **tribes on transportation issues and that would represent tribal**  
8 **transportation concerns at state, regional, and national levels;**  
9  
10 **and**

11  
12 **WHEREAS,** on August 24, 1993, representatives from several tribes met and  
13 **formally established the Intertribal Transportation Association**  
14 **(ITA); and**

15  
16 **WHEREAS,** the Intertribal Transportation Association is modeled after the  
17 **Intertribal Timber Council,** an organization that receives  
18 **administrative funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

19  
20 **WHEREAS,** the Intertribal Transportation Association is of the  
21 **understanding that at this time there are uncommitted**  
22 **Department of Transportation/U.S. Department of Interior**  
23 **funds that could be reprogrammed for Intertribal**  
24 **Transportation Association administrative costs.**

27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Intertribal Transportation  
28 **Association requests funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs**



in the amount of \$200,000 to cover administrative costs for the Intertribal Transportation Association.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Bureau of Indian Affairs use every means at their disposal to make available the uncommitted Highway Trust Funds and that the Intertribal Transportation Association be advised of this effort.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 17TH day of September, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,373.0 FOR; 179.0 AGAINST; 113.0 NOT VOTING; and 98.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


