**RESOLUTION NO. 93-340**

**WHEREAS, on September 15, 1993, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 93-319 supported the 1995 National Indian Education Association (NIEA) Conference to be held in Tucson, Arizona; and**

**WHEREAS, several members of the Tohono O'odham Nation have been attending the planning meetings on their own behalf and interest; and**

**WHEREAS, the planning committee consists of volunteers who have an interest in assisting with the planning of the 1995 NIEA Conference; and**

**WHEREAS, at present there is no official representative from the Tohono O'odham Nation to keep the Nation informed of the status on the upcoming conference; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council after discussion recommended that it would be in the best interest of the Nation to designate representatives to be involved in the planning of the conference; and**

**WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee recommends that a representative, and an alternate, to the NIEA Planning Committee consist of individuals from the following:**




