(Approving Dates for Special Council Meetings)**

2 **WHEREAS, on Friday, September 17, 1993, the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
3 **Council considered two separate requests for Special Council**
4 **Meetings; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee requested a two-day session to**
7 **address the Nation's FY 1994 Budget; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee suggested September 28, 1993**
10 **as the date for a special meeting to consider the open-pit mining**
11 **issue for Cyprus Mine.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham**
14 **Legislative Council hereby approves the dates of September 27**
15 **& 29, 1993 to consider the Nation's FY 1994 Budget.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Legislative Council meet on September**
18 **28, 1993 as requested by the Natural Resources Committee.**

20 **The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
21 **Council on the 17th day of September, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum**
22 **was present with a vote of 1,665.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING;**
23 **and 98.0 (06) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
24 **Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
25 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved**
by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
