14 **submitted an operating budget for FY-94 in the amount of**
15 **\$647,516.00 to support VDI operations; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the proposed VDI FY-94 Budget requests P. L. 99-503 funds in**
18 **the amount of \$283,983.00 to support governance, management,**
19 **training and capital equipment and improvement activities for**

23 **WHEREAS, the proposed FY-94 budget specifies that \$363,533.00 of the total**
24 **budget shall be provided from revenues resulting from VDI**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is in agreement with the proposed Vi-ikam Doag Industries, Inc. FY-94 Budget and hereby authorizes the appropriation of P. L. 99-503 funds in the amount of \$283,983.00 to support governance, management, training and capital equipment & improvement activities for FY-94.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only the interest accruing from P. L. 99-503 funds shall be used to support the activities and items set forth in the proposed VDI FY-94 Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the VDI Board of Directors shall submit quarterly financial reports to the Commerce Committee of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council concerning the status and progress of the Industries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said P. L. 99-503 funds shall be wire transferred from the Nation's Accounting Department to the Vi-ikam Doag Checking Account #2186-4764 at the Bank One Branch Office located in Gila Bend, Arizona in accordance with the payment schedule set forth on page 9 of the proposed Vi-ikam Doag Industries, Inc. FY-94 Budget.




