6 **Cruz/Nestors, under the Indian Community Development Block**  
7 **Program and in connection with the approved grant, resolves**

11 **WHEREAS, prior to the submission of this amendment request the Tohono**  
12 **O'Odham Nation has provided tribal citizens, especially those**  
13 **living in areas where activities are proposed or ongoing, with**  
14 **adequate information concerning the amount of funds available**  
15 **for proposed community development and housing activities, the**  
16 **range of activities that may be assisted, and other important**  
17 **program requirements, and solicited their views and**  
18 **participation; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement were followed**  
22 **through District Council meetings and Tohono O'Odham**  
23 **Legislative Council meetings, and opportunity was given to**  
24 **articulate needs, express preferences about proposed community**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby certifies that the Tohono O'Odham Nation provided its citizens with the opportunity to participate in the development of the proposed Community Development Block Grant request.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that no part of this paragraph shall be construed to restrict the responsibility and authority of the applicant for development of the application and the execution of its Community Development Block Grant Program. Accordingly, the citizen participation requirements of this paragraph do not include concurrence by any person or group involved in citizen participation in making final determinations concerning the findings and contents of this amendment. 


