3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation desires to submit an application**
4 **for a grant under the Community Development Block Grant**
5 **Program for Indian Tribes; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Nation elects to submit demographic data that are**
8 **unpublished and not generally available in order to meet the**
9 **requirements of the application process; and**

11 **WHEREAS, generally available, published data are substantially inaccurate**
12 **or incomplete; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the data provided have been collected systematically, and are**
14 **statistically reliable; the Nation has gathered the Demographic**
15 **Data by conducting a door-to-door survey of the respective**
16 **service area populations and has gathered documentary**
17 **verification of each household's status including family size and**
18 **income and that information is on file at the Nation's Research**
19 **and Planning Office; and**

23 **WHEREAS, data are, to the greatest extent feasible, independently verifiable;**
24 **as cited above, the data was gathered by a 100% door-to-door**
25 **survey and documentary evidence exists in the Nation's Research**
26 **and Planning files as to individual household size and income**

18 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,
19 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
20 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
21 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


