**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the
Children's Initiative Program under an FY 1994 P.L. 93-638
contract with Public Health Services, Indian Health Services;
and**

**WHEREAS, on July 29, 1993 the Nation did submit its FY 1992 SF-269
Final Financial Reports for the Children's Initiative Program
to Indian Health Service and did identify balances to be carried
forward into the FY 1993 contract; and**

**WHEREAS, due to the expiration of the Fiscal Year 1993 Contract and
insufficient time to expend the funds identified, the Nation
requests to de-obligate FY 1993 funds in the amount of
\$45,188.59 from Children's Initiative Contract No. 249-93-0004
and obligate these funds in the FY 1994 Contract No. 249-94-
0004; and**

**WHEREAS, the Children's Initiative Program has prepared and submitted
its budget modification to obligate the amount for review and
approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
