

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

**RESOLUTION NO. 93-416**

**WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office submitted an application for a Cooperative Agreement under P. L. 93-638 to the Bureau of Reclamation ("Reclamation") to complete predesign and design for the Schuk Toak New Farm; and**

**WHEREAS, after extensive negotiations with Reclamation, the Tohono O'Odham Nation agreed to a Cooperative Agreement (No. 3-FC-32-00200, Council Resolution No. 93-356) which provided immediate partial funding for FY 1994; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council understands that further negotiation will take place between the Nation and Reclamation for additional funding and expansion of the scope of work consistent with the Nation's original proposal; and**

**WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office finds that it must submit a supplemental budget to cover critical and necessary staff salaries, support costs and subcontracts not funded by Reclamation, while outstanding items are negotiated; and**

**WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office requests from the Tohono O'Odham Nation, funding in the amount of \$159,090.00 to cover those costs not now funded by Reclamation until outstanding items are**

negotiated and a modification is executed to shift those costs to  
the 638 Cooperative Agreement; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation will seek reimbursement for funds  
previously advanced by the Nation to maintain operation of the  
Water Projects Office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the funding  
request and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the  
attached budget.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that funds in the amount of \$159,090.00 are  
hereby approved from the SAWRSA Trust Fund.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Nation shall seek reimbursement of  
funds previously advanced by the Nation for costs which are the  
responsibility of the Secretary of the Interior under SAWRSA.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council on the 18TH day of NOVEMBER, 1993 at a meeting at which a  
quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 **FOR**; -0- **AGAINST**; -0- **NOT**  
**VOTING**; and 05 **ABSENT**, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,  
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved  
by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).




