**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the  
Community Health Specialty Training Program under an FY  
1994 P.L. 93-638 contract with Public Health Services, Indian  
Health Services; and**

**WHEREAS, on July 2, 1993 the Nation did submit its FY 1992 SF-269 Final  
Financial Reports for the Community Health Specialty Training  
Program to Indian Health Service and did identify balances to  
be carried forward into the FY 1993 contract; and**

**WHEREAS, due to the expiration of the Fiscal Year 1993 Contract and  
insufficient time to expend the funds identified, the Nation  
requests to de-obligate FY 1993 funds in the amount of  
\$8,945.00 from Community Health Services Program Contract  
No. 249-93-0002 and obligate these funds in the FY 1994  
Contract No. 249-94-0002; and**

**WHEREAS, the Community Health Specialty Training Program has  
prepared and submitted its budget to obligate the amount for  
review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council that it does hereby approve the amendment to the**



Community Health Specialty Training budget and request the  
Indian Health Service to incorporate the said budget into the  
Community Health Services Contract No. 249-94-0002.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to  
negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any  
amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this  
Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council on the 18TH day of NOVEMBER, 1993 at a meeting at which a  
quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT  
VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,  
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved  
by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).
