**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the
Community Health Services Program under an FY 1994 P.L.
93-638 contract with Public Health Services, Indian Health
Services; and**

**WHEREAS, notification was received from Indian Health Service advising
the Tohono O'odham Nation of Fetal Alcohol Syndrome/Fetal
Alcohol Effects funds in the amount of \$10,000.00; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did incorporate these funds into
the FY 1993 Community Health Services Contract No. 249-93-
0002 pursuant to Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
Resolution No. 93-336; and**

**WHEREAS, due to the expiration of the Fiscal Year 1993 Contract and
insufficient time to expend the funds identified, the Nation
requests to de-obligate FY 1993 funds in the amount of
\$10,000.00 from Community Health Services - Fetal Alcohol
Syndrome/Fetal Alcohol Effects (FAS/FAE) Program Contract
No. 249-93-0002 and obligate these funds in the FY 1994
Contract No. 249-94-0002; and**

**WHEREAS, the Community Health Services - Fetal Alcohol Syndrome/Fetal

submitted its budget to obligate the amount for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the amendment to the Community Health Services Contract for the Fetal Alcohol Syndrome/Fetal Alcohol Effects budget and request the Indian Health Service to incorporate the said budget into the Community Health Services Contract No. 249-94-0002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 18TH day of NOVEMBER, 1993 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


