**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire that a nursing home be
established for the benefit of its members; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nursing Home Advisory Committee has
been established with the responsibility for the planning,
designing and ensuring the construction of a nursing home for
the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee has submitted its Plan of Operation for
the Nursing Home Project along with the Proposal for the
Allocation of Tohono O'Odham Nation's funds in the
administration of the Nursing Home Project; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council in Resolution No.
93-275 did authorize and allocate Thirty-Nine Thousand, Five
Hundred and Twenty-Four Dollars (\$39,524.00) to be utilized in
the hiring of staff to begin the planning and seeking of funding
support for the design and construction of a nursing home for
the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nursing Home Advisory Committee is requesting for
continuance of Resolution No 93-275.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that funds in the amount of Thirty-
Nine Thousand, Five Hundred and Twenty-Four Dollars
(\$39,524.00) are hereby carried over into the Nations FY 94
budget for the purpose of expenditure for the Nursing Home
Project as submitted by the Advisory Committee in Resolution
No. 93-275 and is provided in Exhibit I, attached hereto.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 19TH day of NOVEMBER, 1993 at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 1,224.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 151.0
NOT VOTING; and 388.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,
1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).


