

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating \$1,579.50 for Border Workers)**

RESOLUTION NO. 93-426

WHEREAS, special arrangements have been made with the Mexican Government to allow members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to drive their vehicles into Mexico during the time of the feast of St. Francis, October 04, 1993, without paying the usual import fee; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Tohono O'Odham Nation and the Mexican Government (INI) will be at the Nogales Border Crossing from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., to assist members in crossing the border; and

WHEREAS, four of the six workers have brought complaints to the Legislative Culture Committee about working conditions, other expenses incurred, and especially of hours worked still owed them; and

WHEREAS, directive from Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on November 17, 1993 for Culture Committee, Budget & Finance Committee, the Border Workers, and Executive come together for an understanding on what the Border Workers be compensated for; and

WHEREAS, the four workers have stated all they were asking for is the hours owed to them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the four workers: Maria Torres, Bernard Mandre, Ophelia Estrada, and Betty Antone be paid according to the budget herein incorporated as part of this resolution in the aggregate amount of \$1,579.50 .

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the funding amount of \$1,579.50 be appropriated from the General Revenues from FY 94.






