RESOLUTION NO. 93-437

**WHEREAS, on November 19, 1993, the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council conducted a presentation on the subject of HIV and
AIDS; and**

**WHEREAS, the Council heard testimony presented by representatives from
the Health, Education and Executive Departments; and**

**WHEREAS, the Council reviewed the Final Report of the National
Commission on AIDS, AIDS An Expanding Tragedy; and**

**WHEREAS, the first recommendation of the Final Report is "Leaders at all
levels must speak out about AIDS to their constituencies"; and**

**WHEREAS, as elected officials, we are convinced that a clear and present
danger to our public health in the form of HIV disease, exists
in our communities now; and**

**WHEREAS, we agree with the National Commission on AIDS that leaders
at all levels must speak out about HIV.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, we, by unanimous action, declare
December 1, 1993, National AIDS Day: A Day of O'odham
Thought and Discussion about HIV Disease.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED we the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
urge all O'odham to attend the HIV and AIDS Community**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, we urge open and frank discussion about HIV
disease at all levels: in the villages, communities, districts,
schools, churches, among our elders and traditional healers,
among our young, in the Nation's offices, in association
meetings and everywhere we come together as a Nation.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, we find that:

- 1. We must act now to educate ourselves and our
communities about HIV disease; and**
- 2. We must reach out with compassion to those among us
suffering from this terrible sickness.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 24TH. day of NOVEMBER, 1993 at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT
VOTING; and 07 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






