

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Prescott College Scholarship Project)

RESOLUTION NO. 94-005

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3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council deems education
4 to be a top priority ensuring the welfare of the Tohono
5 O'Odham Nation and the Tohono O'Odham; and

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8 WHEREAS, Prescott College has received a grant in the amount of
9 \$50,000.00 from the Educational Foundation of America
10 to fund Teacher Aides in a two-three year program to
11 pursue professional teaching degrees; and

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14 WHEREAS, \$20,000.00 of the total grant has been appropriated for
15 use with Tohono O'Odham with the condition that the
16 Tohono O'Odham Nation contribute matching funds of the
17 same amount; and

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20 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Education Department has taken full
21 responsibility of overseeing and administering scholarship
22 funds; and

24 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation funding source has been
25 identified as the 1994 projected revenues.

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27 WHEREAS, the terms and conditions are set forth in the attached
28 Memorandum of Agreement; and

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3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
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5 Council that it hereby approves and appropriates
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7 matching funds in the amount of \$20,000.00 which shall
8
9 be available for obligation until completion of the project
10
11 or until September 30, 1997.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
13
14 Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials to wit:
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16 the Chairman, and any designated official are hereby
17
18 authorized to negotiate and execute the Memorandum of

20 Agreement, provided however, that any amendments
21
22 affecting the funding or funding levels of the agreement

24 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
25
26 Council.

27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
28 Legislative Council on the 3RD. day of JANUARY, 1994 at a meeting
at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0-
AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
vested in the Council by Section 1(d) & (f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting

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Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






