BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
Chairman and any designated Official are hereby  
authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement,  
provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval by  
this Council.

Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






