

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Schuk Toak New Farm Predesign/Design
FY 1994 Budget Modification No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 94-016

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4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation and the Water Projects
5 Office have pursued the completion of archaeological
6 mitigation on the Schuk Toak New Farm project when the
7 Bureau of Reclamation did not provide financial support;
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9 and
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11 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 93-105
12 approve all funding for the completion of archaeological
13 work, but some tasks remained to be finalized as FY
14
15 1993 expired; and
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17 WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office now requests from the Tohono
18 O'Odham Nation, a reappropriation of monies remaining
19 from the authorization provided in Resolution No. 93-105
20 for the archaeological mitigation of the Schuk Toak
21 project. The remainder, as defined in the attached
22 justification amounts to \$38,484.00; and
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26 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation will seek reimbursement for
27 these and other funds previously advanced by the Nation
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to pursue completion of the Schuk Toak New Farm
Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council that it does hereby approve the funding request
and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the
attached budget Modification No. 1

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$38,484.00
are hereby approved from the SAWRSA Trust Fund.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Nation will seek reimbursement of
funds previously advanced by the Nation for costs which
are the responsibility of the Secretary of Interior under
SAWRSA.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council on the 7TH day of JANUARY, 1994 at a meeting
at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; 0
AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).

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




