4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is aware of the fact that
5 there is no longer a EDA set-aside program; and

7 WHEREAS, the health, safety, welfare, education, economic and
8 employment opportunity, and preservation of cultural and
9 natural resources are primary goals and objectives of the
10 Nation; and

13 WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration formerly had a
14 specific set-aside for development projects, but had since
15 been rescinded; and

17 WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration has not
18 increased, and indeed decreased funds once available for
19 Indian Tribes.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's
23 Legislative Council does hereby advocate the need to
24 expand Economic Development Administration resources
25 to reflect the true needs of Indian Tribes and to allow all
26 Tribes access to their planning and public works grant programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Congress should pass legislation that
would restore the Economic Development Administration
Indian set-aside for development of projects and appoint
a Native American liaison who would report directly to the
Economic Development Administration Assistant
Secretary.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that both of these measures would require
raising the overall funding levels of the Department of
Commerce Economic Development Administration and the
Tohono O'Odham Nation fully supports this action.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council on the 7TH day of JANUARY, 1994 at a meeting
at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; 0
AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
vested in the Council by Section 1(b), c(2) & (f) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).






