

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Recommending Repeal of Arizona State Senate Bill 1001)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-022

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3 **WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature passed Senate Bill 1001 as an**
4 **attempt to prohibit casino-type gaming from being conducted**
5 **within the State and in response to the court-appointed**
6 **mediator's selection of the Nation's last best offer for a tribal-**
7 **state gaming compact as the proposal which best comports with**
8 **the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act; and**

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10 **WHEREAS, although, the Governor of Arizona approved S.B. 1001 on**
11 **March 5, 1993, the bill did not become law because of a**
12 **referendum filed with the Arizona Secretary of State by the**
13 **Committee for Fairness in Economic Development, which was**
14 **organized by Arizona Tribes to keep S.B. 1001 from taking**
15 **effect until voted on by the citizens of Arizona in the November**
16 **1994 general election; and**

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19 **WHEREAS, subsequent to the filing of the referendum, the Governor of**
20 **Arizona continued to negotiate with Arizona tribes in an effort**
21 **to reach agreement for tribal-state gaming compacts; and**

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23 **WHEREAS, in those negotiations the Governor of Arizona agreed to seek the**
24 **repeal of S.B. 1001; and**

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26 **WHEREAS, on June 24, 1993 the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
27 **and the Governor of Arizona signed the Tohono O'odham**
28 **Nation-State of Arizona Gaming Compact; and**

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**WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the Nation and the State of Arizona to
repeal S.B. 1001.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation
supports the repeal of S.B. 1001 and recommends to the Arizona
State Legislature that S.B. 1001 be repealed.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation does not
support the amendments to S.B. 1054 but recommends instead
that the State Legislature approve language which simply and
straightforwardly repeals S.B. 1001.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council on the 7TH day of FEBRUARY, 1994 at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT
VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved
by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).**
