RESOLUTION NO. 94-047

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is the governing body of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council was apprised of the President's National Performance Review Initiatives for FY 1995-1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is greatly disturbed by the lack of Tribal consultation on the part of the Department of Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs as to how the adjustment reductions required by the NPR are going to be achieved within the next four (4) fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, the Nation is concerned that savings identified within the Indian Affairs Budget be utilized to offset the federal deficit, when Indian Tribes have never been adequately funded; and

WHEREAS, the NPR must be implemented consistent with self-Determination, self-governance, Indian Preference hiring and Trust Responsibility that the Federal

Government has with Tribes through treaties,
executive orders, etc.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
Nation hereby request the BIA provide proper tribal
consultation and participation of any reduction plans
for the Area/Agency level.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ASIA meet with Tribal Leaders
to discuss strategies for NPR reductions required
on the 1995 Budget and to outline the
consultation process for future budgets.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono Nation present this
resolution to the appropriate Federal Officials,
the National Congress of American Indians, and
the BIA Reorganization Task Force.**


**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council on the 11TH. day of FEBRUARY, 1994 at a
meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0
FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant
to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(l) of Article VI of
the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
