

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(1995 Appropriations Request to Congress - Health)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-050

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation ("Nation") suffers from a number**
4 **of illnesses and diseases including, but not limited to alcoholism,**
5 **diabetes mellitus, Human Immunodeficiency Virus**
6 **(HIV)/Acquired Immunodeficiency Disease Syndrome (AIDS),**
7 **tuberculosis and a lack of emergency medical services and basic**
8 **transportation; and**

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11 **WHEREAS, the Nation, through its health and social services departments**
12 **offers programs concerned with the delivery of services which**
13 **addresses the illnesses and diseases afflicting the Nation; and**

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15 **WHEREAS, present staffing and funding for delivery of such services is**
16 **inadequate to meet the high demand of patients and clients**
17 **suffering from these conditions and the continuing rise in the**
18 **number of patients and clients needing services; and**

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20 **WHEREAS, Indian Health Services (IHS) has been directed to implement**
21 **FTE ceiling and administrative budget cuts which further**
22 **impacts on already inadequate staffing and resources to fully**
23 **meet the demand and rise in the incidence of the Nation's illness**
24 **and disease; and**

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27 **WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Nation to address the many health needs of**
28 **its members.**

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3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
4 **Council that it does hereby urgently request that Congress**
5 **appropriate \$13,869,663 in accordance with the attached**
6 **proposals, to assist the Nation in meeting the rise and demand**
7 **for health services.**

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9 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
10 **that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby authorized**
11 **and directed to bring this request to the appropriate members**
12 **and committees of Congress.**

16 **Council on the 24TH. day of FEBRUARY, 1994 at a meeting at which a**
17 **quorum was present with a vote of 1,583.0 FOR; ~~0~~ AGAINST; ~~0~~ NOT**
18 **VOTING; and 180.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
19 **Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**
20 **O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,**
21 **1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
22 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,**
23 **1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
