3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the**
4 **Family Preservation Program under the Title II of the**
5 **Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA); and**

7 **WHEREAS, such Social Service operations have been successful**
8 **and beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its**
9 **people; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department has**
12 **the primary responsibility to provide for the care,**
13 **treatment and welfare of children found to be in need**
14 **of such care; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the incidence of child abuse and neglect in the**
17 **Tohono O'Odham Nation is high and increasing and**
18 **family intervention and prevention services are**
19 **limited; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department has**
22 **developed and administered a home based, intensive**
23 **family service program which focuses on preventing**
24 **family breakups and reunification of families; and**

27 **WHEREAS, there is a continued need for a program which**
28 **preserves the family through service provision; and**

9 **Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department as herein**
10 **stated.**

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
13 **Council authorizes the Tohono O'Odham**
14 **Appropriations Committee to submit this request**
15 **in the amount of \$225,032.00 to the appropriate**
16 **members and committees of Congress.**

28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






