3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has two districts, Chukut**  
4 **Kuk and Gu Vo District, which are bordered by the**  
5 **International United States/Mexican Boundary; and**

6  
7 **WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk and Gu Vo District of the Tohono**  
8 **O'Odham Nation both have experienced problems with**  
9 **drug smuggling, cattle rustling and the spreading of**  
10 **disease from the Mexican cattle to the United States,**  
11 **Tohono O'Odham cattle; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District with the support of the Gu Vo**  
14 **District hereby requests fencing material to replace**  
15 **the International Boundary fence in order to alleviate**  
16 **some of the problems along the International United**  
17 **States/Mexican Boundary.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham**  
21 **Legislative Council that it hereby supports the Border**  
22 **Fencing request in the amount of \$230,406.00 as**  
23 **outlined in the attached budget proposal.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate officers of the**  
26 **Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring**  
27 **this request to the appropriate members and**  
28 **committees of Congress.**




