

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1995 Appropriation Request - Law Enforcement
Tohono O'Odham Police Department)**

RESOLUTION NO. 94-064

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million
acres and a population of 18,000 members contracts its own Law
Enforcement Program under P.L. 93-638; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department is inadequately funded
and understaffed to provide coverage to all areas of the Nation;
and**

**WHEREAS, this lack of funding and staffing creates a public safety hazard
for members of the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department has identified specific
areas of proposed increased staffing and equipment to address
this serious problem; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation supports
the Tohono O'odham Police Department in their request to
increase their funding under P.L. 93-638.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation
requests appropriation for an increase in funding for the Tohono
O'odham Police Department in the amount of \$1,570,759.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
authorizes the Appropriations Committee to submit this request
in the amount identified to the appropriate members and
committees of Congress.**




