**WHEREAS, as a result of a Memorandum of Agreement between  
the Indian Health Service, the Tohono O'Odham Utility  
Authority and the Tohono O'Odham Nation entered  
into on October 11, 1991, information, materials and  
supplies regarding compliance with the Safe Drinking  
Water Act have been provided to the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, this Project is now complete and is of great benefit to  
the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Constitution requires affirmative  
action by the Legislative Council to "acquire property,  
transfer or convey assets to the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation", (Article VI, Section 1 (i) (3) and (5).**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation  
accepts transfer of all information, materials and  
supplies provided pursuant to IHS Project No.  
TU-91-634, which will be used by the Tohono  
O'Odham Utility Authority in conjunction with**




