**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council's agenda for March 7, 1994
included as item #3 Special Session Requests; and**

**WHEREAS, Chairman of the Commerce and Budget & Finance
Committees, did by memorandum dated March 2, 1994,
request for a special session on March 21, 1994 to
address the Distribution of Revenues; and**

**WHEREAS, Chairman of the Investment Committee has also, by
memorandum, requested March 23 & 24, 1994 for
special sessions on presentations from four financial
organizations regarding investment purposes; and**

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did discuss said requests.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council hereby sets March 21, 1994 as a
special session to address the Distribution of Revenues.**

General Session.**
