**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Utility Authority (Authority) has
constructed numerous projects for the Indian Health
Service under Memorandum of Agreements over the past
nineteen (19) years; and**

**WHEREAS, Public Law 93-638 allows the I.H.S. to contract directly
with Tribes and/or Tribal organizations for construction
of water and waste facilities under P. L. 86-121; and**

**WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Tohono O'Odham Utility
Authority has authorized and directed the Management
and Staff of the Authority to submit the necessary
resolution and documents to the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council for implementation of said
resolution; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has determined that
implementation of this process will benefit the Tohono
O'Odham Utility Authority, Tohono O'Odham Nation and
their respective members.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
Council does hereby request that the Indian Health
Service implement the provision of P. L. 93-638**


14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham

18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(i) & 2(d) of Article VI of the
19 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
20 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
21 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




