23 **Resolution 94-032 which supported the Arizona DES**
24 **Division of Developmental Disabilities to work**

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 94-032, the Tohono O'odham Nation formally requested representation on the Board of Directors of the Pima Council on Developmental Disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Pima Council on Developmental Disabilities has invited the Nation to appoint a representative to become a member of the Pima Council on Developmental Disabilities (PCDD).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby appoints Kathleen Antone as its official representative to the Pima Council on Developmental Disabilities.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 8TH. day of MARCH, 1994 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.533.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 230.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
