site identified for the facility; and

WHEREAS, an archaeological testing report was issued on May 17,
1993 which also included a draft Data Recovery Plan
for the proposed site, and where said report was
submitted to the Arizona State Historic Preservation
Office (SHPO); and

WHEREAS, it had been determined that the construction of the proposed Multi-Purpose Facility within the San Xavier District will have an effect upon the Archaeological Site AZ AA:16:375 (ASM), and upon properties determined to be eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places and therefore constitutes an undertaking as defined in 36 C.F.R.s 800.2(o); and

WHEREAS, the Nation, as the lead agency for this undertaking, has consulted with the Arizona State Historic Preservation

Office (SHPO) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) on its intent to proceed forward with a data recovery plan for the site as part of clearance toward construction of the Multi-Purpose Education Facility.
