3 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District received notice that the 8th**  
4 **Annual Substance Abuse Conference to be held in**  
5 **Mohave, Arizona on April 6, 7 and 8th will be having**  
6 **special prevention activities for youth; and**

8 **WHEREAS, approximately 56 District youth have expressed a**  
9 **desire to take part in the activities; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Alcohol Program, Health and Human Services and**  
11 **Community Education staff have recruited eight adults**  
12 **to serve as chaperons; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Gila Bend School System is willing to excuse**  
15 **District youth attending the Institute from classes, and**  
16 **is donating school van transport to participants to and**  
17 **from the Institute; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Substance Abuse Program has**  
20 **expressed a willingness to provide a van for**  
21 **transportation; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council approved by Resolution**  
24 **on March 25, 1994 the expenditure of I.I.M. currently**  
25 **available in the District, however, said expenditure was**  
26 **not contained in the District FY-94 Budget for this**

4 **participate in this program and the Community, as**  
5 **expressed in a recent Public Hearing, desire a greater**  
6 **range of prevention activities for Village youth.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham**  
9 **Legislative Council hereby approves the expenditure of**  
10 **the San Lucy District's I.I.M. funds currently in the**  
11 **District account in the amount of \$4,572.00 to support**  
12 **this activity.**

17 **Legislative Council on the 28TH day of MARCH, 1994 at a meeting**  
18 **at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,763.0 FOR; -0-**  
19 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 03 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers**  
20 **vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the**  
21 **Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the**  
23 **Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on**  
24 **March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
25 **Stat. 984).**
