WHEREAS, 24 25 subject to strict compliance with the Investment Policy 26 and pending approval of the investment advisor(s) for 27 the Nation, (1) all the Nation's investment accounts be 28 maintained at First Interstate Bank of Arizona (the

"Bank"), and (2) the Investment Committee be authorized to designate an official in the Executive Branch to (a) approve or disapprove investments recommended by the Bank and (b) direct liquidation of investments needed to assure the Nation timely meets its financial obligations arising in the daily operation of the government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Legislative Council hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Investment Committee, in consultation with the Committee and the Chairman of the Nation, to designate an official of the Nation, and to change such designee, who shall be authorized to (1) approve or disapprove investments recommended by First Interstate Bank with respect to the Nation's funds maintained by the Bank and (2) direct the liquidation of investments needed to assure adequate funds for the Nation to timely meet its financial obligations arising in daily governmental operations; provided that this authority is granted solely for the period ending on September 24, 1994; and provided further that, not less than monthly and such
