WHEREAS, the Investment Committee has recommended that, subject to strict compliance with the Investment Policy, (1) all the Nation's investment accounts be maintained at First Interstate Bank of Arizona (the "Bank"), including the Savings Account for Casino revenues now maintained by the Fund, and (2) the Savings Account be designated as a long-term account pursuant to Resolution 94-098 and the Investment Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Legislative Council hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Investment Committee and the Chairman of the Nation, in consultation with the Committee, to (a) establish a separate account at First Interstate Bank of Arizona to be known as the Desert Diamond Savings
